1. The meeting was called to order with additional accommodation for the public through the use of Zoom Meetings at 9:00 A.M. Board President Scott McKinney called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

3. CONSENT ITEMS

Mr. Neal made a motion to approve Consent Items 3.1. and 3.2. Mr. Barr seconded; motion passed 5-0 (AYES: Barr, Clemens, Dashner, McKinney, Neal).

4. **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

4.1. <u>Finance Committee</u>

Chief Johnson reported that it was the last few days of this fiscal year and there will more revenue than expenses for the year.

4.2. <u>Personnel/Safety Committee</u>

Chief Johnson reported that staffing was at 100% with the recent hiring of Mark Prozorov. He also reported there was a new Battalion Chief Eligibility List effective July 1 from the seven candidates testing. He thanked Battalion Chief Matt O'Donnell for his work preparing the testing process.

4.3. <u>Fire Prevention Committee</u>

Chief Johnson reported the committee had discussed the two violation notices that were included later in the Board packet. The staff had begun hanging and distributing "no fireworks" signs throughout the District and there were to be three permitted safe and sane scheduled events.

4.4. <u>Apparatus/Equipment Committee</u> No report.

5. SCHEDULED ITEMS

- 5.1. Braun Northwest: New Ambulance Build Increase in Chassis Cost
 - Chief Johnson introduced Tami McCallum of Braun Northwest who had agreed to explain the manufacturing industry as it had changed from the governmental availability and pricing of chassis and vehicles. Tami McCallum outlined the ongoing issues with trying to obtain a Ram vehicle for the current ambulance being built for EPFD. She explained how the unit was found and was currently being picked up but was going to cost more than originally agreed because it was retail price. After some discussion, Mr. Neal made a motion to approve the cost increase for the chassis as presented for the ambulance. Mr. Barr seconded; motion passed 5-0 (AYES: Barr, Clemens, Dashner, McKinney, Neal). The Board members thanked Tami McCallum for her explanation and continued work on the District's behalf.

5.2. Big Trees MD: Presentation of NFPA 1582 Physical Medical Exam Program

Chief Johnson introduced Dr. Maryal Concepcion who has been working with the District for physicals for the firefighting staff. Dr. Concepcion told the Board members about her work toward the NFPA standards of care with the goal of keeping the firefighter on the job longer and to not bench them. She reviewed the plan to have the employee's exam +/- 30 days before their birth date. She overviewed the appointment making process and continued with an explanation of the MET test. Chef Johnson noted the work that Dr. Concepcion has done for the fire district. The Board members thanked her for the presentation and her work toward the program. Chief Johnson noted there would be a contract created for Dr. Concepcion

5.3. Introduction of Draft Policy 6800 Personnel – Physical Medical Exam

Chief Johnson noted the first draft of the policy was presented in the Board packet. The 30-day review period could be easily extended as staff and the Board members review it. Mr. Dashner made a motion to adopt Draft Policy 6800 Personnel Physical Medical Exam for 30-day review. Mr. Barr seconded; motion passed 5-0 (AYES: Barr, Clemens, Dashner, McKinney, Neal).

1. Purpose

To provide a standard of initial, annual, and bi-annual medical physicals for members as defined in this policy.

Provide criteria outlining the approved process for various agency members to adhere regarding minimum medical physicals.

Increase the likelihood of early detection of firefighter occupational medical risks.

2. Member(s) Minimum Physical Medical Exam Requirements

2.1. Auxiliary, Administrative only, and non-primary fire prevention workers must complete a "DOT physical" <u>equivalent</u> physical at time of joining the organization.

2.2. Volunteers, per diem hires, and interns must complete a "New Hire Firefighter Physical" at time of joining the organization.

2.3. Full-time firefighting members must complete a "New Hire Firefighter Physical" at time of joining the organization and complete an "Annual/Biannual Firefighter Physical" every year for those 41 or over and every other year for those 40 and under.

We want to thank you for your participation and support of the SDRMA benefits program. This year marks 17 years that SDRMA has been an administrator of the Small Group Health Benefits Program under Public Risk Innovation, Solutions, and Management (PRISM).

Each year, the medical benefits renewal is based on a 12-month rating/claim period. For the 2024 renewal, the 12-month rating/claim period was from March 2022-February 2023 (based on available claims data at the time the renewal is calculated). During this timeframe, the PRISM and SDRMA Programs saw the following factors drive high medical inflation for the 2024 medical renewal.

- Higher than historical trend
- High catastrophic claims
- Increase in baseline medical costs and fees paid to providers stemming from higher labor costs, clinical staffing shortages, and overall inflation on supply chain costs
- Approval and expanded use of new medical technology and procedures
- Rising costs of prescription drugs and specialty medications

Listed in the below table is the percentage increase effective January 1, 2024, for medical plans as well as other benefit plans.

The attached 2024 SDRMA Health Benefits brochure includes the final 2024 rates for SDRMA benefit plans as approved by the PRISM Health Committee on May 24, 2023. Per the IRS 2024 updates to High Deductible Health Plan (HDHP) minimums/maximums, SDRMA's HDHP 10 deductible will increase from \$1,500 individual/\$3,000 family to \$1,600 individual/\$3,200 family effective January 1, 2024. The 2024 SDRMA Health Benefits brochure rates reflect the change to the HDHP 10 deductibles.

Your agency's current SDRMA benefit plans will automatically renew for 2024 unless we receive a written withdrawal notice by September 1, 2023. *If your agency would like to make any plan changes effective January 1, 2024, such as changing a medical plan or adding a medical plan, SDRMA must be notified of the plan changes no later than August 14, 2023, to ensure the plan changes are built in our system in time for Open Enrollment.*
